Comfort is key when you're at home, and we replicate the same solace at HOUSE. Perched atop Dempsey Hill, HOUSE is a 4,000 square-foot residence-gallery to everything that's visually stimulating. From plating to comforting, creative gastronomy that combine local flavours with the global palate to tease and please curious taste buds; to the lush woodland surrounds, and even the stunning works of art dotted around the property - HOUSE possesses the elements of a true multi-sensory experience.





KUBRICK ROOM

HOUSE is made up of a main dining hall and 3 private rooms known as Kubrick, Karenina and Bette Davis.



KUBRICK ROOM

Seating Capacity: 50-60pax
We are flexible with the arrangement in this room such as a semilounge and dining set-up for up to 50pax as demonstrated here. It may also service as an entertainment room.



KUBRICK ROOM

Seating Capacity: 50-60pax
A clustered seating is recommended for 45pax and above.
This set-up was done by one of our clients using artificial flowers and battery-operated candles.



KARENINA ROOM

Seating Capacity: 10-12pax
This is usually the bridal room and we will provide a portable mirror.
If not in use, the client may opt to seat their guests in here.



BETTE DAVIS ROOM

Seating Capacity: 20-25pax
This is a multi-purpose room which can be used to conduct tea
ceremonies or where close family members can relax and kids can play.




BETTE DAVIS ROOM

Seating Capacity: 20-25pax
We can convert this space into a dining room if the main hall is not sufficient to accommodate all your guests.



OUTDOORS

This is where we will hold the solemnisation ceremony. We recommend a maximum audience of 30pax to be seated behind the solemnisation table.


You have a choice of using the brown chairs, banquet chairs covered with a white cloth or these tall grey chairs. Do note that these chairs are subjected to availability.



A reception table can be arranged under one of our tents at the entrance of the restaurant.



We can also set it up in front of our restaurant signage on a welcome carpet.

The main buffet line is arranged at the front of the restaurant on a long table which sits 20pax.



Alternatively, we can also set-up the buffet line against the windows.



The buffet line is split into 2 sections. Half of the table is occupied by the mains in chaffing dishes as shown in the previous picture and the other half of the table is occupied with the soup, salad and the appetiser. Shown in this picture is the charcuterie platter and mixed salad.

You may choose to include free-flow coffee/tea and basil lemonade as part of the package.




DESSERT TABLE

Double chocolate tart, gula melaka, cheese platter, cranberry cheesecake, lime cheesecake.












All tables next to the glass windows are joint to sit 6-7pax across 2 sets of tables.

Flowers and wedding favors provided by the couple and placemats provided by HOUSE.



You may choose to print your own placemats like what this couple did, completed with their Instagram hashtag.




HOUSE FLOOR PLAN




HOUSE FLOOR PLAN
